


#### **Monthly Summary**

During November 2017, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Wilsonville on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time deputies assigned to Wilsonville responded to 568 calls for service, which was an average of 18.9 calls a day.







#### **Traffic**


